6Ps of Evacuation:

- 1 -People & pets
- 2 -Papers & important documents
- 3 -Prescriptions, eyeglasses
- 4 -Pictures & irreplaceable objects
- 5 -Phone, computer, chargers
- 6 -“Plastic” & cash

Inside the House

- › Pack your ‘Go Bag’
- › Close all windows
- › Clear away light curtains
- › Move anything that burns easily to the middle of rooms
- › Leave lights on for firefighters to see your house in smoke
- › Switch off the air conditioning
- › Close all doors
- › Check with neighbors

Outside the House

- › Bring in flammable items like patio furniture
- › Attach garden hoses for firefighter use
- › Don’t leave sprinklers on it lowers water pressure
- › Turn exterior lights on to make your home visible
- › Load car facing outwards
- › Don’t wait for an evacuation order if you feel at risk
- › Close garage door, leave gates open on exit
