- III. Milner Hard Closure Survey Analysis

The results of the Milner Hard Closure during high volume Hollywood Bowl events will be discussed. An analysis with possible suggestions to send to the HHWNC Board for distribution to LADOT, LA Philharmonic Association, Supervisor Barger, and Council Districts 4 and 13 will be considered.

729 mailers sent out from ZIMAS addresses. 110 returned non deliverable. Oldest neighborhood in the City. County assessor's map is incorrect. Survey was both hard copy and digital, with a unique code. County assessor map and ZIMAS are incorrect with Milner's and Las Palmas' mapping. City service will not go out to people requesting services.

14% return of the survey. Upper Grace would like to continue hard closures. South Grace does not. Street is furthest away from Milner. Only access to Whitley Heights is from the South, Franklin. Milner needs to be a hard closure to make way finding apps not send people through the neighborhood. Las Palmas wanted to keep it closed. Where can a hard closure be put other than Milner that would be more beneficial to more?

Responding to "What else do you want us to know" on the survey, people were requesting that locals be let through, pointing to the fact that education needs to be done on the State Law not allowing that. Need to start working with the State on changing the State Law, which will see it as discriminatory practices.

There should be an incentivization of the ride share program discussion.

Motion: The Area 3 Committee asks the Board of the Hollywood Hills West Neighborhood Council to request that the City, before it rezones, take corrective action on the errors in ZIMAS. As a point of communication to HHWNC stakeholders from developers and City organizations, ZIMAS falls fall short of achieving notification purposes. Passed 6 yay, 0 nay.

HHWNC Housing Chair will hear Area 3 Stakeholders issues of concern re Area 3 Housing issues. Items may be considered for motion(s) to the Board or topics for further discussion at a subsequent meeting.

Discussion on new laws coming in from State or City. RINA numbers putting restrictions on jurisdictions. What is important in regards to "policy." Also questioned to put forward HHWNC's position on ED1. Discussion about ED1 in Historic Zones, and people's choices to where they live and CEQA as not being able to be applied to policy.

Also questioning affordability enforcement and preservation issues. Halfway houses were also discussed.

Agreement to continue discussion at another meeting.
